

Your Role at the RCTC Studio Considering COVID-19

Before you get to the studio:

1. Register and pay online to secure your spot.
2. Fill out the COVID-19 questionnaire honestly.
3. Do not come to the studio if you are feeling unwell.

When you get to the studio:

1. Remember to bring and wear your facial covering.
2. Please wait outside the main door (on the sidewalk) until the instructor lets you in. Remember to keep your distance from other students.
3. The instructor will once again ask you some questions relating to COVID-19. Please answer honestly.
4. The instructor will let you inside, assign you a square in the studio and ask you to sanitize your hands.
5. After sanitizing your hands, promptly find your spot and have a seat.
6. Remember that facial coverings are mandatory in the studio at all times.

Leaving the studio:

1. The instructor will dismiss students one at a time. Please wait your turn.
2. The exit door goes into the RCTC parking lot. Please exit quickly to your ride or towards the bus stop.
3. Do not linger outside the studio with others as this will no longer follow Public Health Orders, could endanger your health or could shut down the studio.

Expectations in the Studio

Respect

- Respect the instructor: Listen when they are speaking and ask questions if anything is unclear.
- Respect your peers: Be an attentive audience when your peers are performing and be prepared to offer constructive criticism for both yourself and your peers.
- Respect yourself: Allow yourself to make mistakes but always try your best.

Inclusion

- Everyone is different and brings unique ideas to the table.
- Practice compromise and collaboration by including multiple contributions.
- Do not bully or seek to exclude others. This behaviour will not be accepted in the Studio.

- No performance will not be perfect, always do your best and keep growing.
- Practice new things and consider the studio a safe space to make mistakes.
